

DIRECTIONS FROM ST. LOUIS (FROM EAST)

Hwy 270 to Hwy 44 West get off at the Eureka exit (number 264) the exit before Six Flags, come down the ramp and turn left go under the highway and turn right onto 4th street, by the Quick Trip. Go about 2 blocks and we are on the corner of 4th and Central at the overpass. We have a two story brick building with a black and yellow awning and a large plastic horse outside.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE WEST

44 East get off at the Eureka exit (number 264) the exit after Six Flags, come down the ramp and turn right. Turn right onto 4th Street at the first stop light by the Quick Trip. Go about 2 blocks and we are on the corner of 4th and Central at the overpass. We have a two story brick building with a black and yellow awning and a large plastic horse outside.

DIRECTIONS FROM HOUSE SPRINGS AT HWY 30

Take Hwy W North turn right onto Hwy 109/W. Turn left onto 4th Street at the stop light by the Quick Trip right before Hwy 44 exit. Go about 2 blocks and we are on the corner of 4th and Central at the overpass. We have a two story brick building with a black and yellow awning and a large plastic horse outside.

DIRECTIONS FROM MANCHESTER/Hwy 100

Take 109 South to Eureka, go under Hwy 44 and turn right onto 4th Street at the stop light by the Quick Trip right before Hwy 44 exit. Go about 2 blocks and we are on the corner of 4th and Central at the overpass. We have a two story brick building with a black and yellow awning and a large plastic horse outside.

DIRECTIONS FROM HWY 40, St Charles, St Peters, Wentzville areas North

Take 40 east and get off at the Chesterfield Airport Rd. Turn Right onto Olive by the first gas station you come to. It will wind around behind the airport, cross some rail road tracks and go up a big hill. At the stop sign at the top of the hill go straight onto Hwy 109. Take 109 South to Eureka, go under Hwy 44 and turn right onto 4th Street at the stop light by the Quick Trip right before Hwy 44 exit. Go about 2 blocks and we are on the corner of 4th and Central at the overpass. We have a two story brick building with a black and yellow awning and a large plastic horse outside.
